IMPORTANT REMINDER TO ALL PARENTS/CARERS

Dear Parents/ Carers

THE SCHOOL'S CODE OF CONDUCT IN RESPECT OF ELECTRONIC DEVICES
(Copy Code of Conduct attached)

No student is permitted to bring into School any electronic devices whatsoever. Examples include MP3 players, memory sticks, mobile or camera telephones, IPad's, Kindles, iPods, PSP's, DS's or any other form of electronic device.

It has come to my attention that a number of pupils are repeatedly bringing mobile or camera telephones into School and therefore disobeying a very important School rule.

This is totally unacceptable and I must inform all parents/carers that should any pupil be found with any electronic device in School it will be confiscated by staff and will only be re-issued to an adult with parental responsibility.

Concession to students who travel independently to School

The School acknowledges that many parents/carers prefer their child to carry a mobile telephone for safety reasons whilst travelling to and from school independently. A concession will therefore apply to these students only provided they hand in their mobile telephones to a member of staff on arrival at School. Telephones will be re-issued at the end of the school day.

I trust that you will discuss the seriousness of the contents of this letter with your child and do your best to support the School by encouraging them not to bring any of these items into School.
