

## **Impact of Pupil Premium 2015 -2016**

The impact of this funding:

1. Reduced exclusions
2. Improved academic success for those attending, 'Closing the GAP'.
3. Improved resources, for academic support: IXL, Reading Eggs, P3 Initiatives.
4. On-site psychological services and a range of in-house therapies eg MiLE, & Light Therapy.
5. Staff training on de-escalation Techniques, and Physical Interventions, Anger Management.
6. Restorative Practices, some staff have already experienced some training, 15 staff will experience a week of input with all staff having training in the coming financial year.
7. Reduced number of Physical Interventions.

## **Pupil Premium 2016 -17**

**The Pupil Premium Grant for the financial year 2016/17 is £87,890 and we propose to utilise this Grant in the following areas:**

- In response to our research into Strengths & Difficulties and 'Emotional Intelligence':
  - Termly Emotional Intelligence Target Setting & Monitoring
    - 'Emotional Intelligence' & 'Strengths & Difficulties' monitoring
  - Development of 'Pathfinders Project' working with families and pupils with barriers to learning. (3 Staff initially trained).
    - Conflict Resolution – Restorative Approaches
  - PRIME Training – de-escalation techniques
    - Further & Ongoing Anger Management Training
  - Continual improvements to facilities eg School Farm
  - Continued onsite Psychologist
  - Educational Visits
  - Software licences for Maths & English Extension eg Education City
  - Activities to develop self-esteem and self-regulation
  - Interventions
    - 1:1 support
    - Assessment/support from Psychologist
    - Access to the MILE
    - Wild Crew programme
    - Outdoor Education programme

- School Farm
  - Attendance monitoring and chasing up.
  - Restorative Meetings with pupils/staff.
  - P3 Programme (enhanced support for Reading and Maths).
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- We forecast that all pupils will make expected progress academically but, more importantly, we will be anticipating improvements in their 'Emotional' wellbeing and Attendance. Academic progress will be monitored termly with intervention support being put in place for any pupil falling behind.
